



2.13 AKHENATEN'S RELIGIOUS CHANGES

Akhenaten

Karnak

Tn 1352 BC, the pharaoh Amenhotep III died. His son became the new pharaoh, Amenhotep IV. Like his father, Amenhotep IV disliked the power of the priests of Amun. The centre of the power of the priests was the great Temple of Amun at Karnak, just outside Thebes. Amenhotep IV chose the sun god, Aten, as his personal god. Many of the previous pharaohs had chosen Amun. As soon as he became pharaoh, Amenhotep IV started to challenge the power of the priests of Amun. He built a new temple at Karnak dedicated to Aten. Within five years he had made some huge changes. He changed his name to Akhenaten ('beloved of Aten') to show how important Aten was to him. He built a new capital city, el-Amarna, to rule from instead of Thebes. Amenhopet

The new city had a new great temple - to Aten.


Akhenaten made Aten the most important Egyptian god. He did not force everyone to worship Aten, but he made Aten so much more important that other temples, such as the temple of Amun at Karnak, lost much of their power, importance and wealth. Akhenaten was trying to change a country that, for hundreds of years, had worked in a very similar way. Change usually happened very slowly in Egypt. Akhenaten's changes were very significant - a new capital city, a new most important god, and because of this a new set of most important priests. Many people were shocked by Akhenaten's changes

- especially the priests of Amun. They led opposition to his changes. Historians call

the opposite of change 'continuity'. So which won in the end
