The longest is 40453m long.










TRADICIONAL CLOTHES






SCHOOLS IN SLOVAKIA



DIVISION OF SCHOOLS

- kindergarten (for children from 3 years to 6 years)
- primary school (for children from 6 years to 15 years)
- high school (for children from 15 to 19)
- university (for people from 19 years)
- every child must go to school for 10 years



SPECIAL PRIMARY AND HIGH SCHOOLS

- Some schools are different from others, as bilingual, art schools, sports schools,...
- Private schools are paid by the students and State schools are free of charge





DAY IN OUR SCHOOLS



The school starts at 8:00 and ends at different times.

One lessons last 45 minutes, the breaks last 10 or 15 minutes and are between every lesson.

Some pupils have got lunch at school which is after classes


From 1st to 4th class is 1st stage, and from 5th to 9th is 2nd stage.

Younger pupils have got one teacher for every subject, but older pupils have different teacher for every subject.


