- Discover other languages (oral and written) and cultures through music, dance, folklore, food, daily routines, national costumes, city landmarks, booklets, promoting the fact that the whole educational community was not only involved with learning but also teaching.
- Compare new technologies of education as well as educational systems from several countries, enriching the experience of both students and teachers.
- Involve the staff, families and local institutions, enabling them to take part of the Project, this is essential to its development: their cooperation and collaboration, as well as planning and developing different activities .
- To involve the teaching staff, families and local institutions, enabling them to take part in the project, being essential to their own professional development through their cooperation and collaboration: in the planning and development of the different activities carried out in the centre, in the fostering of the members from other countries, disseminating the project and its results which were obtained before, during and after its delivery, etc.
- Awakening curiosity to discover other places around the world that surround us and increase awareness of intercultural ideas promoting greater awareness regarding the importance of cultural and linguistic diversity in Europe.
